The French Coalition for the Decade is organising the second edition of the International Salon for Peace Initiatives, which will be held in Paris on June 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup>, 2006, in the Centre des Congrès de la Villette. In the framework of the preparation of this international event, the French Coalition for the Decade is happy to present to you the poster of the Salon.

Jean-Michel Luard and Thierry Deffrenne, respectively conceiver and photographer of the poster, have realised it free of charge for us. They are both winners of the Advertising Festival Awards and of the 2003 Public Prize for the best poster for a great cause, for the last Amnesty International campaign on arms transfer control.

In the continuity of the first Salon organised in 2004, this second Salon is part of the "International Decade for the Promotion of a Culture of Peace and Non-violence for the Children of the World (2001-2010)" declared by the UN. It will be the occasion for around a hundred and fifty exhibitors to present their peace initiatives and to propose animations, exhibitions, films and workshops the visitors.

In the framework of this second Salon, the *International Conference "Actors for a Culture of Peace and Non-violence"* will favour common reflection and debate on the culture of peace and non-violence and will encourage the creation of synergies at the international level. Through six roundtables and sixty workshops, it will gather actors for peace from all over the world, engaged in the promotion of a culture of non-violence, among whom Adolfo Pérez Esquivel, Nobel Peace Prize (Argentina).

This Salon is placed under the High Patronage of the UNESCO, leader organization of the Decade. This High Patronage has been attributed on March 10<sup>th</sup>, 2006 by Mr. Koïchiro Matsuura, Director-General of the UNESCO.

The partners of that event are the CCFD (Comité catholique contre la faim et pour le développement), Non-Violence XXI, associative fund for a culture of non-violence in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century, Partage and the Secours Catholique-Caritas France.
